Financial Report

Michael Higgs tabled the financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2018. He discussed the Profit and Loss statement and explained the Balance Sheet and associated notes. The financials show the Club made a profit of approx. \$23,500.

The fee for the auditor this year was \$1,320, which was a substantial discount on the prior year. All were pleased with this fee and agreed to appointed the auditor being S J Hutcheon of Stewart Brown Chartered Accountants.
